In the way shown me by Jesus I'll walk.

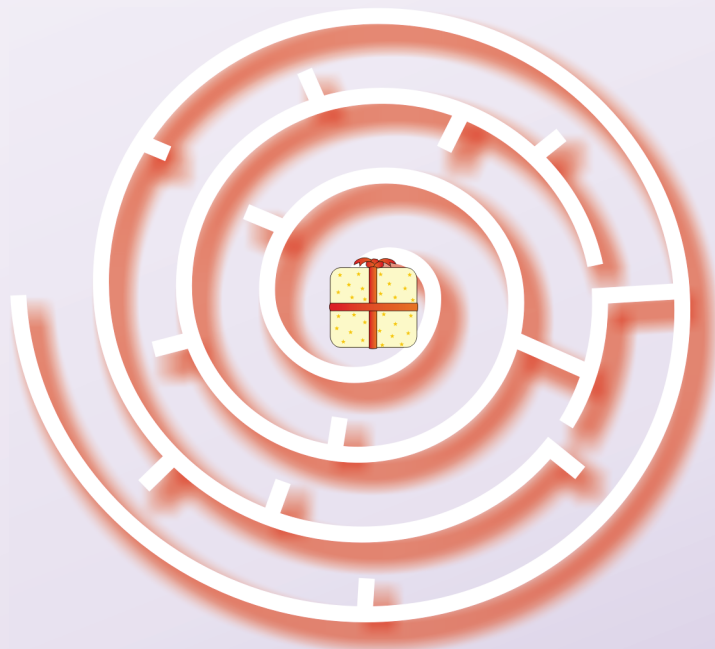
I will do good; I will do good,
