Lesson Plan "Mission through Family Life":

Objectives:

- Understand the importance of family in Christian mission
- Learn how to live out Christian values in family life
- Develop skills to share faith with others through family relationships
- Analyze the role of family in evangelization and missionary work

Starter:

Tell the story of how Cornelius and his family and Lydia accepted Christianity(refer the chapter introduction from text book and may refer Bible for more details).

Presentation of Topic:

Introduction

- Introduce the concept of mission and its importance in Christian life
- Explain how family life can be a powerful tool for mission

Biblical Perspective on Family and Mission

- Bible verse Hebrews 13: 1-6
- Discuss biblical examples of families involved in mission (e.g., the Holy Family, the apostolic families)
- Explore biblical teachings on family life and its connection to mission (eg: Acts.10,
 - Acts 16, 1Cor:16:15)

Living Out Christian Values in Family Life

- Discuss how Christian values such as love, forgiveness, hospitality and family prayer can be lived out in family life
- Explore how these values can be shared with others through family relationships

Sharing Faith through Family Relationships

- Discuss ways to share faith with extended family members, neighbours, and friends through family relationships.

- Explore how to use everyday opportunities to share the Gospel with others.
