Lesson 10 Jesus and his disciples

Important points from chapter:

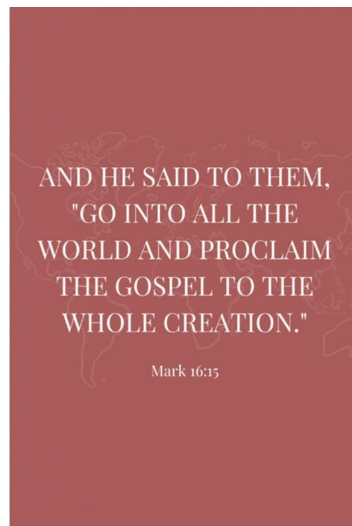
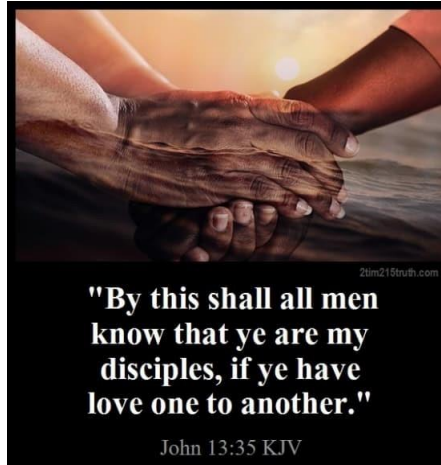
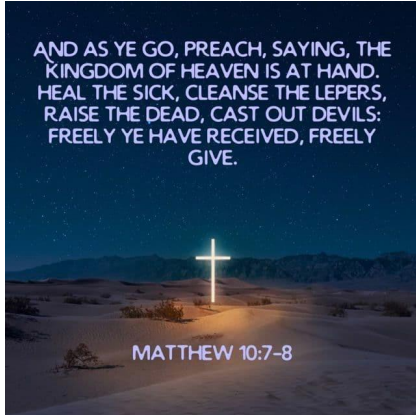
- 1.** Jesus preached about the love of God the father.
