Lesson Plan – Lesson 6 : Annunciation

Objective: Students should understand the story of the Annunciation and recognize Mary's obedience to God's plan.

Starter:

Story :-

Once in a lively village, there was a young boy named Alex. His parents asked him to tidy up his toys before bedtime. Though tired from playing, Alex obediently cleaned up, knowing it made his parents happy. Once his parents saw that he had cleaned the room, they were very happy and appreciated him for his prompt obedience. As he snuggled into bed, he felt happy, knowing he had done as asked and pleased his parents.

Presentation :

Explain the story of the Annunciation using simple language, focusing on the following key points:

- The angel Gabriel visited Mary.
- Gabriel told Mary that she would give birth to a special baby named Jesus, who would be the Son of God.
- Mary was disturbed and asked how it could happen
- Gabriel explained that the Holy Spirit would make it happen, and nothing is impossible with God.
- Mary accepted God's plan with faith and obedience, saying, "I am the Lord's servant. Let everything you've said happen to me."

Practical Application

- Discuss with the students the concept of obedience
- Ask students to think about times when they've had to obey their parents, teachers, or God, even when it was difficult.
- As Mary accepted the will of God, we too must accept his will.

Bible Verse
