MATRIMONY

OBJECTIVE:

- Students will understand that God set up the family.
- Marriage is a sacrament and Parents are Gods representatives.

STARTER:

Start the class with story of Adam and Eve. How they were created and relate how God unites man and woman in the sacrament of Holy matrimony

PRESENTATION:

- Define Marriage.
- The most important factor of marriage are mutual love and faithfulness between husband and wife.
- Man and women form a family in marriage.
- Marriage exists in all religion. For us marriage is a sacrament.
- Then explain about the rites of marriage like blessing by priest, accepting the consent of bride and bridegroom, tying of thali, exchange of rings, adorning the mantracodi, taking oath, exchange of garland, etc.
- Children are Gifts of God. God protects and blesses the family through parents.
- An ideal family is one where parents love their children and children obey their parents.

- Pray for your parents every day
- Obey your parents

BIBLE VERSE:

Mk 10:9

ACTIVITY:

Let children write about the names of their family members(extended like grandparents, uncle, aunty etc).

Let children write 5 positive points on their family members
