

LESSON PLAN

CHAPTER 7

Covenant Keepers

Std 7th and 8th

Jesus who took upon himself our wounds

Objective

1. Jesus offered himself as a sacrifice for the remission of sins of all mankind.
2. Jesus was lifted up on the cross so that whoever believes in him, will have eternal life.

Introduction

- a. Tell the story about why Moses erected the Bronze Serpent. (Numbers 21:6-9)
- b. Explain the context and inference of Peter's proclamation of Jesus as the Messiah.
- c. Explain Jesus' foretelling of his death, suffering, and resurrection.

Presentation

- a. Isaiah's prophecy of the "Suffering Servant" being fulfilled in Jesus in the New Testament.
- b. Jesus was wounded for our transgressions and crushed for our iniquities.
- c. It is our duty to comfort and bring relief to those who are suffering in our community and society.

Habit Formation

- a. Impart the attitude of "I must love Jesus who suffered persecution for my sake".
- b. Teach children that they have a duty to comfort those who suffer pain.
- c. Inculcate an attitude to offer their small sacrifices or prayers during Holy Qurbana for good of others.

Bible Verse

Isaiah 53:5

Activity

- a. We shall present the lesson through an activity of the 'Rosary of Bible Verses'

Let the children say the Sorrowful Mysteries. Give one mystery to each group. Let them write that mystery on a chart paper and stick pictures relevant to the same. Ask each group to find out a Bible verse that is

suitable for the mystery. Let them write that on the chart paper. When the rosary of Bible Verses is complete, display it in the class.

Conclusion

End the class with a short prayer thanking Jesus for giving himself on the cross for our sins and our salvation.
